
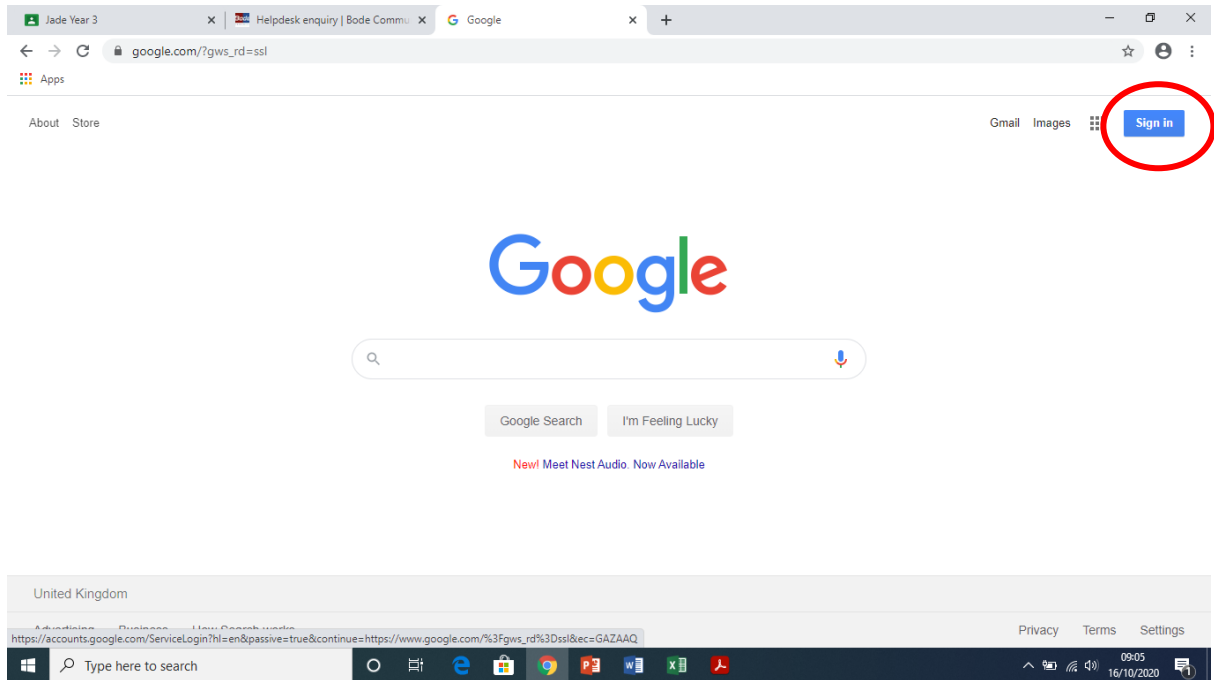


## How to Join a Google Classroom

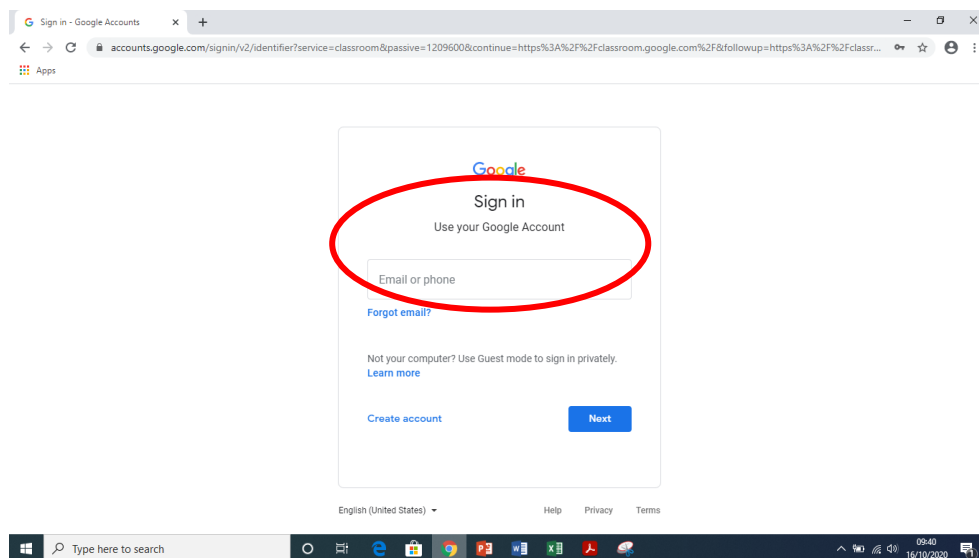
### Step 1:

Open Google and press the blue  button.



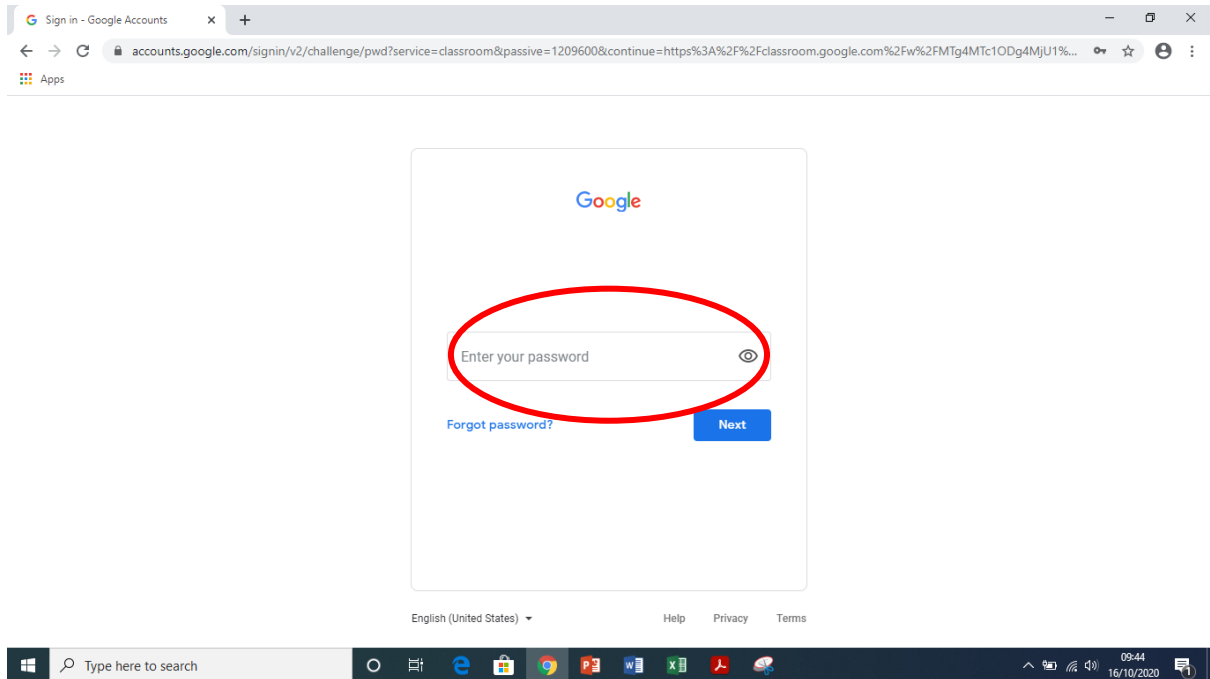
### Step 2:

Enter your child's Google email (first name + surname followed by @loose-primary.kent.sch.uk e.g. johnsmith@loose-primary.kent.sch.uk)



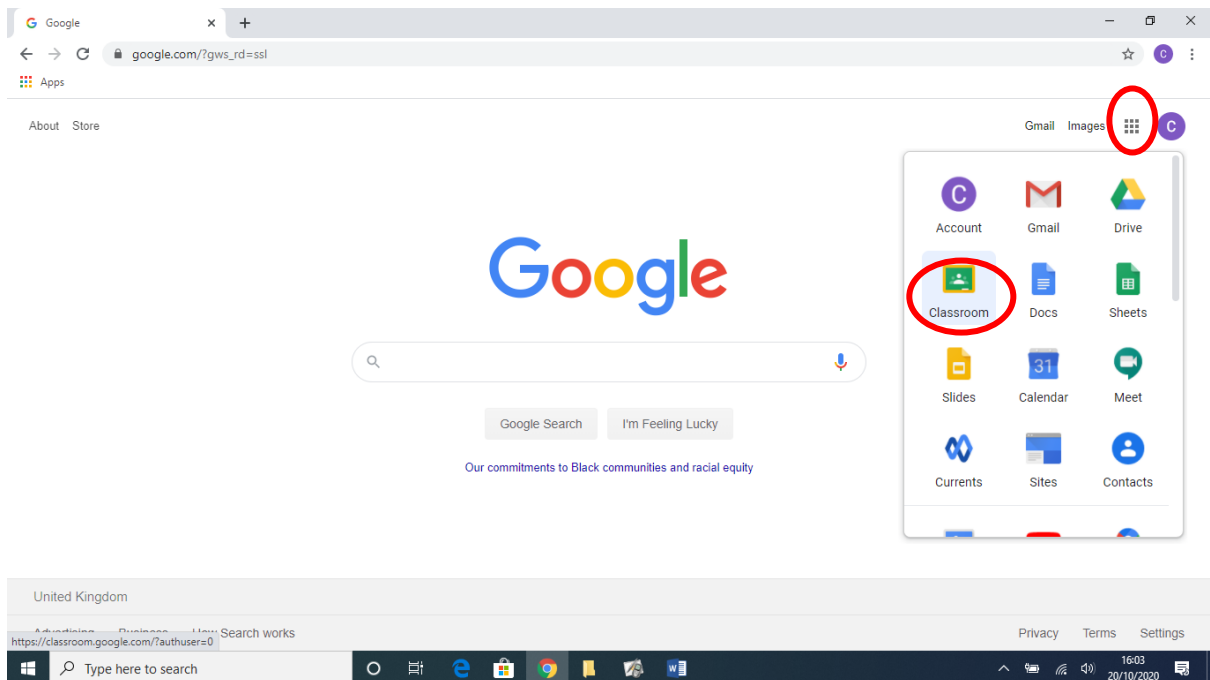
### Step 3:

Enter your child's password (date of birth ddmmyyyy e.g. 01012020)



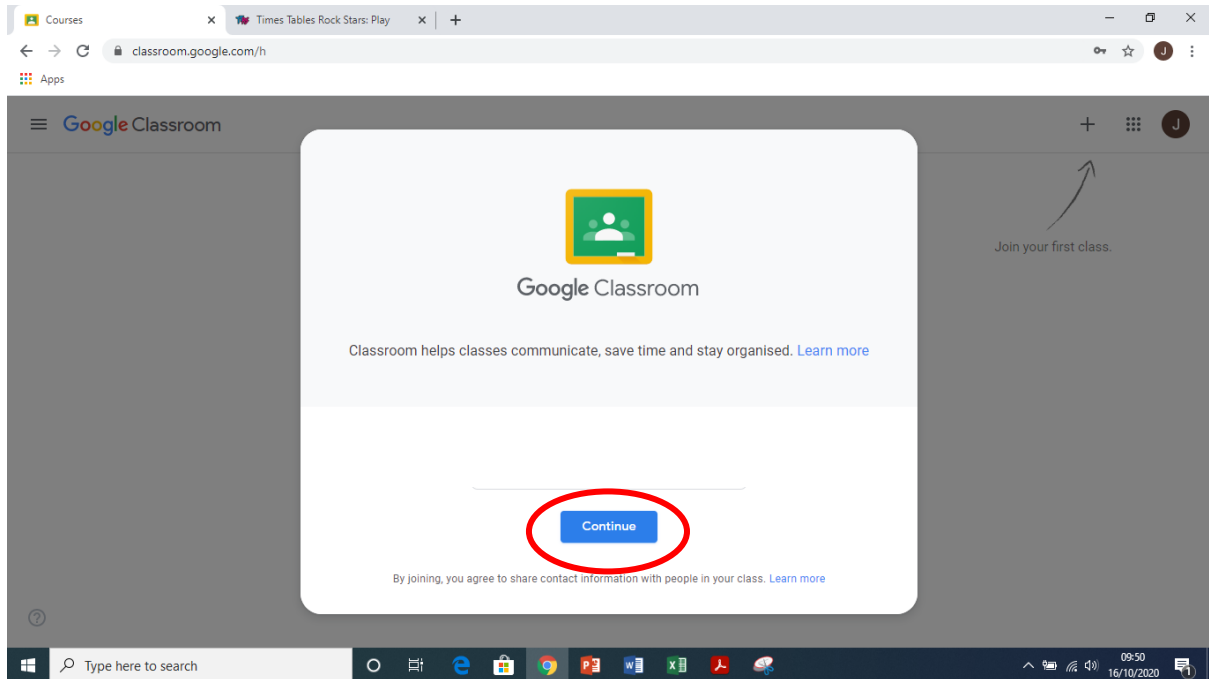
### Step 4:

Your child will now be signed in. Press the waffle button (9 dots) and select Classroom.



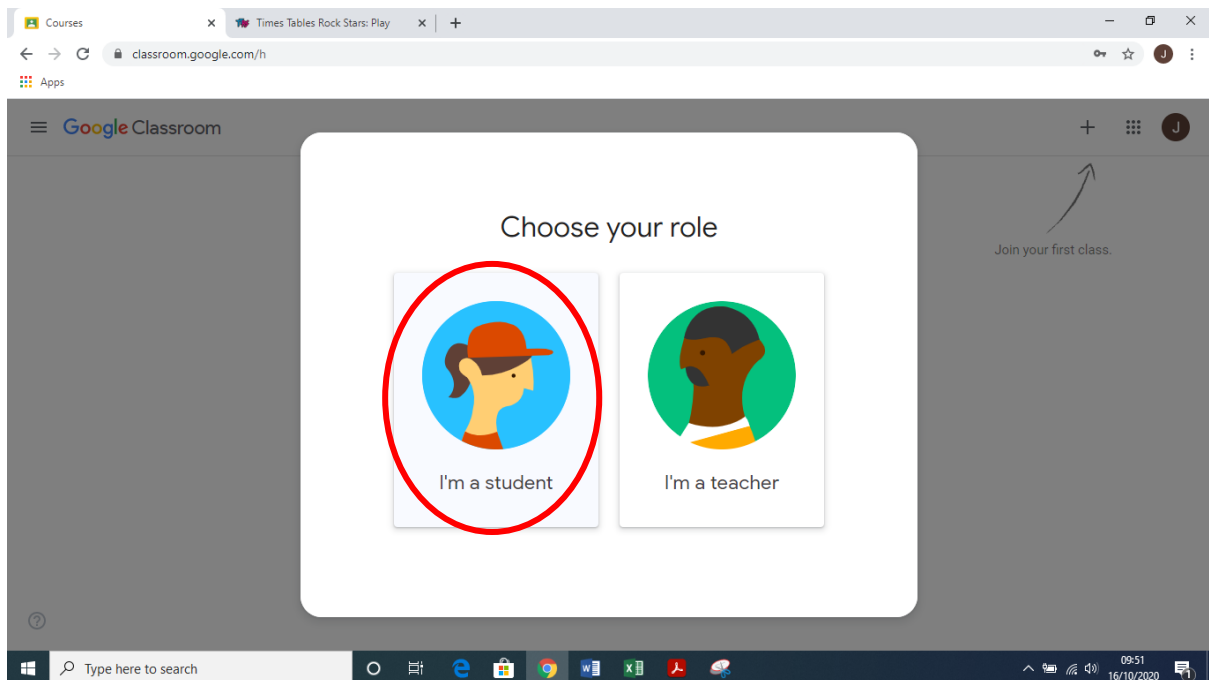
## Step 5:

Press continue.



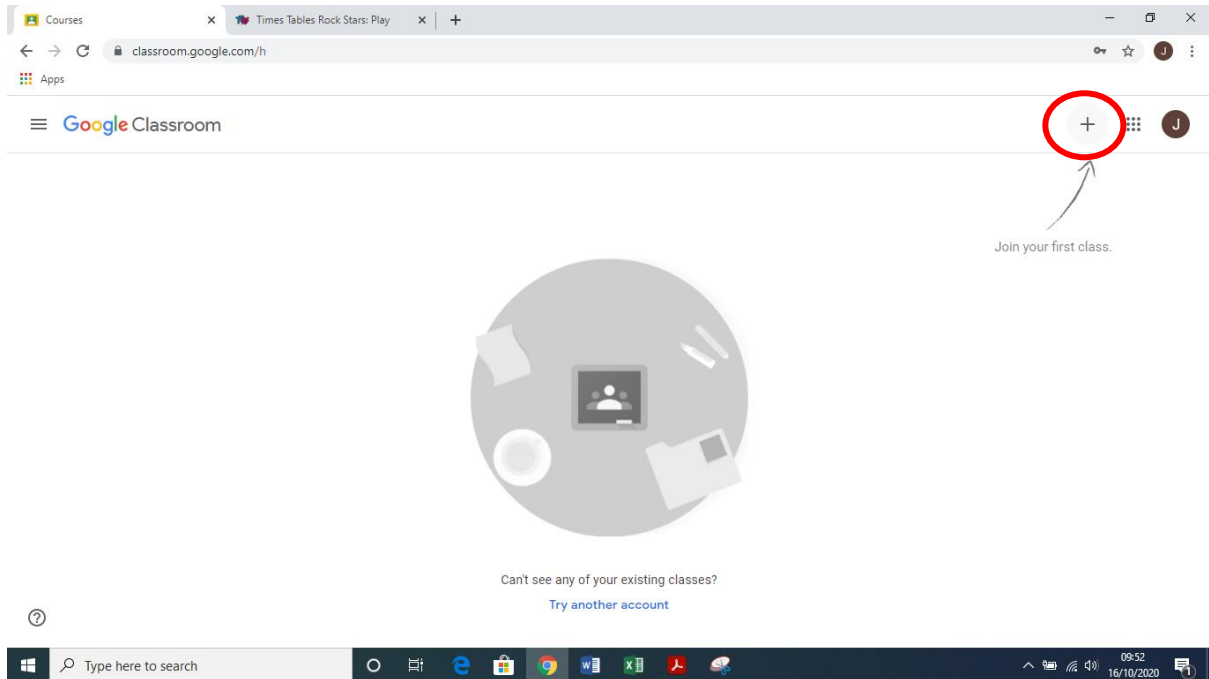
## Step 6:

Select student.



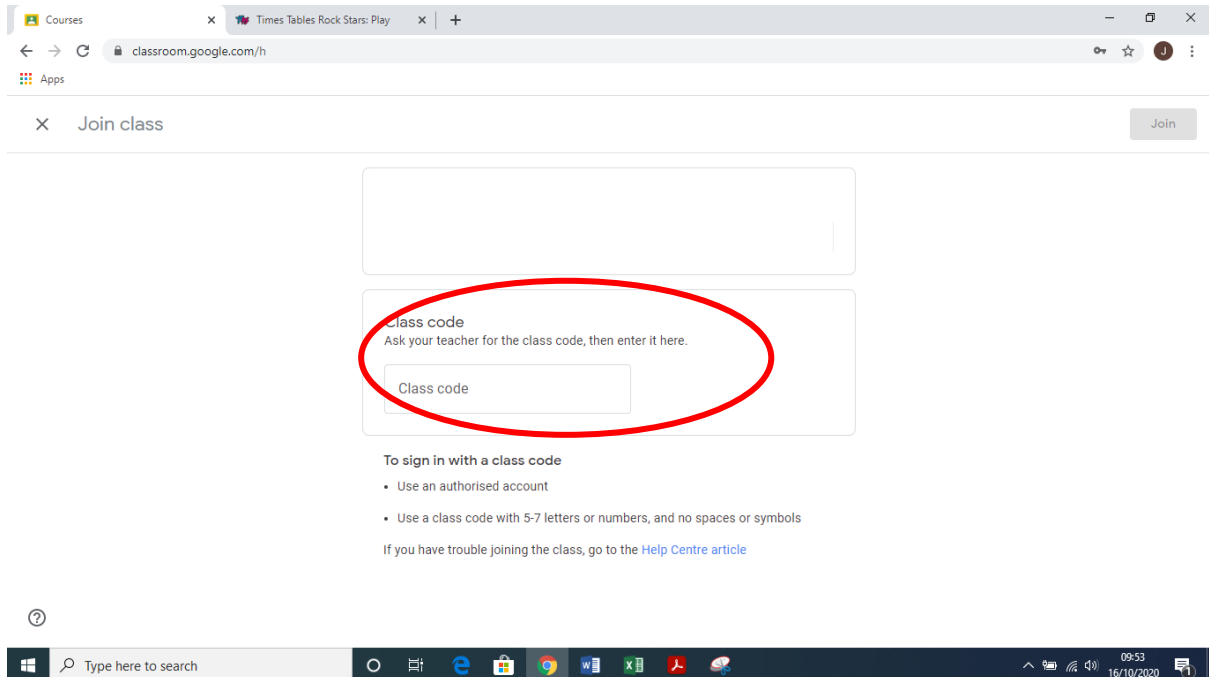
## Step 7:

Press the + button




## Step 8:

## Step 9:


Press join in the top right.
