



After a few weeks of home learning, we want to try and introduce systems and routines to the children that they will be used to. After listening to some feedback from parents, we have developed this support for you to try and use the ladder system at home. We would suggest only use the ladder linked to them completing remote learning and not general home behaviour. We're sure you already manage that amazingly well. We have included a list of our school values at the top. These are good to remind the children of and use them when moving them up or down e.g. You have shown amazing determination. Move up the ladder.



Top of the ladder:

If your child reaches the top of the ladder you may wish to give them a certificate. An example certificate is available to download from the school website in the Remote Learning section.

Children should start the day in the middle of the ladder.

For positive behaviour e.g. completing their work, helping round the house, being polite, etc. they can move up the ladder.

Moving down the ladder. If your child at home isn't listening or behaving how you expect with their school work you may wish to move them down letter. We also aim to move children back up to the middle when they present positive behaviour.
