WHAT HAVE WE LEARNT?

English: We are learning to write an animal fact file. We have been focusing on using question marks, commas and possessive apostrophes in our writing.

Phonics: We have been learning the /oe/ sound which can be spelt using the spellings <oe>, <ow>, <ou>, <o>, <ough> and <oa>.

Maths: We have been exploring which operation would be best used to work out our calculations involving mass. The children have also been problem solving using their reasoning skills.

Science: We are learning about materials. We explored why John Dunlop used rubber to make a pneumatic tyre and the impact of that on our lives today e.g. riding a bicycle.

Geography: We have been looking at hot and cold weather across the world and how we identify and record weather using charts.
