WHAT HAVE WE LEARNT?

English: In our next piece of writing, we will be showing what we have learnt so far this term such as commas and different questioning. Including capital letters, full stops and expanded noun phrases into our work.

Phonics: We have been learning the /n/ sound which can be spelt using the spellings <n>, <nn>, <kn>, <gn>, and <ne>.

We have been focusing on polysyllabic words.

Maths: We have been exploring different types of measurements. We have been making 'potions', measuring the liquid to the correct milliliters asked and using grams and kilograms to weigh items.

Science: We are learning about how materials can change shape. We are experimenting with different materials by which items can be squashed, twisted, bent or stretched.

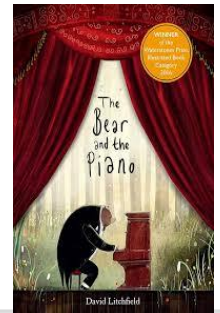
Geography: We are beginning to carry our own fieldwork to see where the best places to grow flowers on our school grounds will be.
