Your child will need the following:

- Named swimming bag
- Named swimming costume (for boys **swimming trunks**, not shorts for health and safety reasons)
- Named towel
- Verruca sock(s) if your child has a verruca(s)
- Swimming hats for all children with collar length hair or longer. These children will not, under any circumstances, be allowed to swim without a hat. We do not keep spares because of the problem with headlice.
