Phonics – Parent Meeting

Dear Parent/Carer

Our aim is for every child in Year One to develop a secure and confident understanding of phonics, providing them with the essential skills they need to become fluent and enthusiastic readers.

To support you in helping your child at home, I will be hosting a **parent meeting on Friday 26th September at 2.00pm**. The meeting will finish by at least 3.10pm to allow you time to collect your children. The purpose of this session is to explain the way we teach phonics in school and to share strategies that will enable you to reinforce this learning effectively at home.

During the meeting, I will demonstrate the systematic approach we use in the classroom and model the correct pronunciation of each sound. You will also be introduced to a range of simple activities and resources that can be used at home to make phonics practice both enjoyable and impactful.

This session will also provide an opportunity for you to ask any questions you may have about phonics and to gain greater confidence in supporting your child's progress.
