### WHAT HAVE WE LEARNT?

It's been a busy and exciting time in class, with lots of learning happening across the curriculum!

In maths, we have been strengthening our understanding of the four operations, with a particular focus on short and long multiplication. The children have also explored factors, multiples, and square and cube numbers. Next up, we'll be tackling long division – a big step, but one we're ready for!

In English, we have been working towards persuasive writing inspired by The Cogheart Express. The children have been experimenting with persuasive devices such as exaggeration, rhetorical questions, direct address, emotive adjectives and presenting opinion as fact. It has been wonderful to see them becoming more confident and creative with their arguments.

Our science lessons have been hands-on and full of curiosity. We carried out an experiment with light, testing how the distance from a light source changes the size of a shadow. The children not only enjoyed the investigation but also practised writing up their findings clearly.



In history, we have been learning about the Industrial Revolution. We compared the housing of factory workers with those of the wealthy and discussed the Victorian voting system. Our classes agreed that it was very unfair indeed – and had plenty of strong opinions about it!

In PSHE, we have been exploring the topic of money choices. This included discussions about spending wisely, saving, and the risks of gambling. The children considered the possible consequences of gambling and thought carefully about how to make responsible decisions when it comes to money.
