WHAT HAVE WE LEARNT?

What a fantastic term it's been! The children have had a great term, learning about the Benin Kingdom, hooked about Morrigan Crow, and practical science experiments involving forces.

Maths – In maths, the children have completed their learning on addition and subtraction. They have learnt how to add and subtract up to 1,000,000 with great accuracy and use this knowledge in multi-step word problems.

Literacy – In literacy, the children have completed their diary entry for Morrigan Crow's experience in the fright trial. They have used 'show, not tell', adjectives and noun phrases to enhance their writing. They have worked hard to edit and publish their final entries, taking care and pride in their learning.

Science – This term the children have been carrying out exciting experiments to discover air resistance, gravity, and water resistance. The highlight was seeing the children use a lever system to lift a 1kg weight using only 50g on the other end!
