

Dear Year Three Parents and Carers,

We've had a busy and exciting couple of weeks in Year Three. Last week we had helpful sessions about road safety with important messages to keep us safe. This week Coral and Amber class have been excited to take part in their class assembly to their parents. Their teachers have been very proud of their performances and thank you for all the adults who were able to make some time to come and see them. Jade class have been practising hard and will get their turn to show you all their fantastic assembly next week!

In Guided Reading, we have continued to read our exciting text, The Land of Roar! We have spent some time remembering what we have read so far, summarising the key events. The book is a super adventure, and the children have been very excited about what will happen next to Arthur and Rose! Will they ever rescue their Grandad?

In Writing, the children have continued to work on our unit about Trolls. They have been learning about prepositions to describe where their Trolls are. They have also been using a greater variety of conjunctions to create longer sentences. We are now planning our reports on trolls and are looking forward to sharing them with you when we have finished writing them.

In maths we have been working with three-digit numbers recording our calculations as column additions and subtractions. We used the maths manipulatives to help us to make the numbers and then have been recording them carefully making sure we show any exchanges we have made. We have included the white rose guides to place value and subtraction which explain the methods we have been using in class so you can support your child at home.

Thank you for continuing to support the children reading at home. Some children have now received their first certificate for reading 50 times. Please continue to sign your child's reading record every time they read so we can celebrate with their progress. Remember there are lots of ways to support your children with their learning at home. Every week we focus on a new sound for spelling, and using spelling shed games can help the children learn them. In maths it can be helpful to use TT rockstars for quick retrieval of times tables facts.

We have our Christmas jumper day coming up on the 11th of December. We look forward to getting into the Christmas spirit with the children on that day which is also their Christmas lunch day.
