What a fantastic term we have had in Year 6! The Christmas cheer has certainly been spread and we are very excited for the festive period.

This term has seen us undertake some more assessments. The children did remarkably well, showing great determination and taking real pride in their learning. We are very proud!

In literacy, we have finished writing our reports about Pandora. The children have published these pieces in their beautiful learning books, and the outcomes are stunning. We have since begun writing a report based on another planet. We are really enjoying the opportunity to be creative with our own planets!

Year 6 have been working hard in maths this term, focusing on developing their confidence with converting between different units of measurement.
