WHAT HAVE WE LEARNT?

English: We are writing our instructions for our disgusting sandwich recipe book. We have been ensuring that we know what a verb and an adjective is so that we can include them in our writing.

Phonics: We have now learnt different spellings for the /e/ sound, with the most common being <e> and <ea>. Before Christmas we will learn /ou/ spelt <ow> and <ou>.

Maths: Children have been using their knowledge of number bonds and the part-whole model to support them in completing subtraction problems.

Science: With a good understanding of the structure and classification of animals, we have now been considering their diets and using the vocabulary carnivore, herbivore and omnivore to describe them.

Geography: We have looked at the key human features which define the difference between a town and a village. Which is Loose – how do you know?

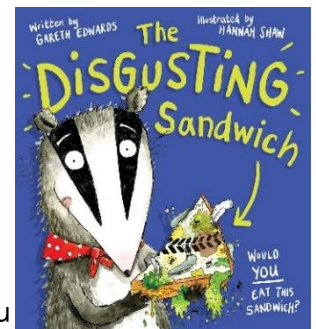
RE: We have been learning about what celebrations we all have and how we go about celebrating these in preparation for learning the Christmas Story.
