Headteacher News

Dear community,

This week I want to pause and celebrate everyone who makes Loose such a warm, safe, and loving school. From our fantastic pupils to our dedicated support staff and teachers, there is a collective spirit here that shines through every corridor. We really are dreaming for our pupils and each other. You can feel it in the happy voices of children walking through the corridors, collecting registers or moving to lunch and break. They help, they talk and they care greatly. It can be seen celebrated in our assemblies where their hard work and learning are showcased with pride too.

A special highlight this term has been the growing success of our older pupils using the *Reading Plus* programme. As we roll it out across the school in KS2, more and more children are

accessing it at home as well as in school, and the difference it is making is already clear. Mrs. Spelman will be sending more information shortly. One of the wonderful things about the programme is the ability to track average reading minutes each week. We would encourage every family to aim for **at least 60 minutes of reading per week**, as this makes a big impact on progress. We will keep you updated on this as the year goes on. If you need advice on accessing it at home - please just ask. Its a wonderful resource!

We also want to take a moment to thank and recognise two wonderful members of staff - **Mrs Wells** who left last week and **Mrs Todd** who leaves at the end of next week. Both have been at the heart of Loose life, bringing joy to our school lunches, breaktimes, extended services, and daily smiles for both pupils and staff. Mrs Todd is moving into the secondary sector, while Mrs Wells went off to be a super nanny! We will miss them dearly and wish them every happiness in their next chapters.

This week our leadership team along with visiting headteachers and our trust team were working together to evaluate and further strengthen our work around inclusion and equality for all. It has been encouraging to see the positive impact of our recent strategy to connect more closely with parents of pupils with a special educational need. The 1:1 parent meetings which are now held three times a year in addition to parent consultations are helping families feel more confident in supporting their children and knowing what the school does too. The additional strategies and resources we are seeing in classrooms are already making a difference. Pupil voice has been especially powerful: children spoke so warmly about their experiences in school, with many comments bringing genuine tears of joy to those listening. They expressed how loved and included they feel here at Loose— a true credit to our team and to the incredible leadership of our SENCO, Mrs Black.

A few reminders on **uniform**: our classes are looking very smart, but we have noticed a few children forgetting ties and wearing trainers already. The mornings may be rushed and busy but please ensure your children wear the correct uniform as this is what we expect. It's a tough battle without home support. Please support us in ensuring ties are worn properly, shirts are tucked in, and smart school shoes are all present as part of our daily uniform. This reflects the pride we take in belonging to Loose. Our value of *Limitless Potential* is about self-determination and doing the hard things—even something as simple as keeping our uniform standards high. We will continue to remind pupils if uniform is not correct, and your support is greatly appreciated.

As ever, thank you for your support and challenge. I'll leave you with a question to reflect on: *What wonderful things in our daily lives at Loose might we sometimes take for granted?*

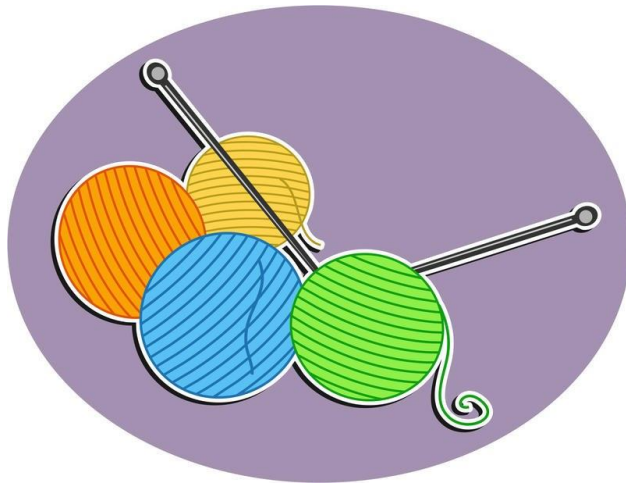






A plea for wool!

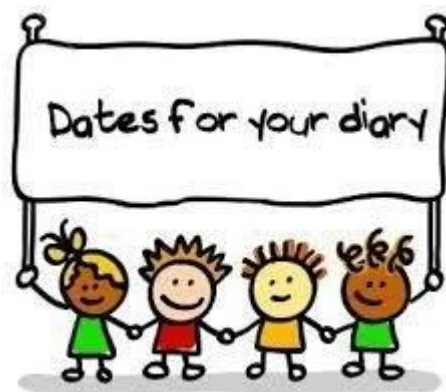

Photos

On Tuesday 7th October and Wednesday 8th October, Fizz photography are due to visit Loose Primary School for both class and individual photographs for years R through to 5 only. Year 6 will be due their photographs later on in the year prior to leaving Loose in the summer.

Due to having over 300 sibling groups within our school, we are not able to take sibling photographs within normal school hours. Fizz photography have kindly agreed to provide an early drop in sessions instead on Tuesday 7th October for parents to bring their children in for sibling photos themselves. This session will run from **7.15am until 8.30am** and will be on a first come, first serve basis. If the demand is too high we may need to turn parents away as the sessions can't overrun as children need to get to school on time and the photographers need to set up to start taking class & individual photos at 9am.

For safeguarding reasons, once your children's pictures have been taken you must leave the school site via the main gates and return at the usual time for the start of the school day. This is because there will be breakfast club children on site. If your child is going to breakfast club after their photo has been taken then please drop them off as normal afterwards.

Tuesday's drop in session will be in Brook Hall.

Please note that choir has been cancelled that morning as both halls will be in use.

Applications for 2026

For children starting year 7 in September 2026 applications are **now open** and will **close on Friday 31 October 2025**.

You can apply for up to 4 schools.

- Put the schools in the order of preference.
- We strongly recommend you use all 4 preferences on your application form. Initially, we are only able to look at schools you have named. If you do not name a local school, families who did name it may fill its spaces. This means it may no longer be an option if we cannot offer you one of your preferred schools.
- Naming only one school does not guarantee your child a place or give priority for a place over another child.
- You are not able to name the same school more than once.

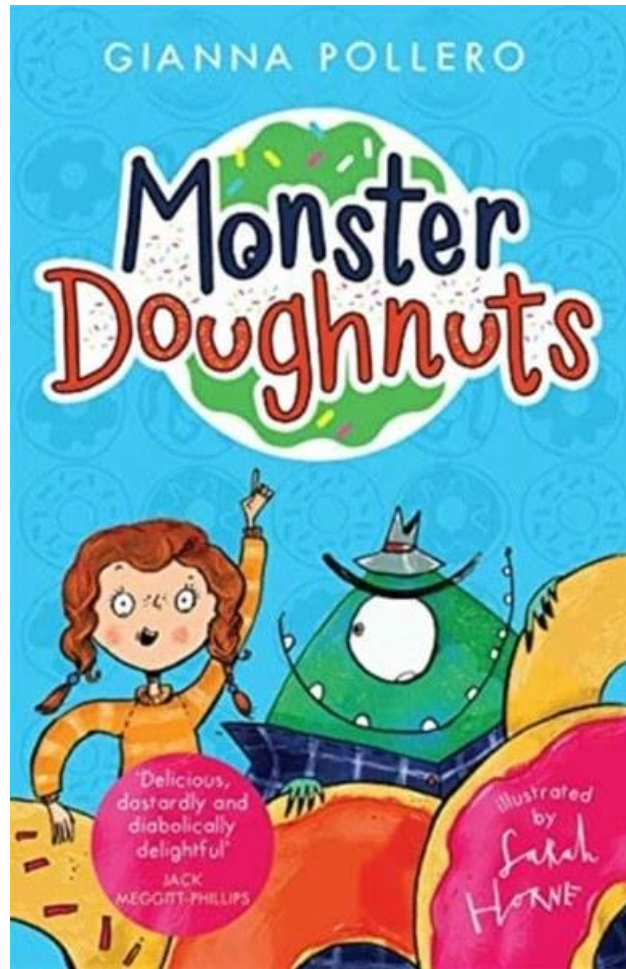


Author Visit Years 3 to 6
