World Book Day – Thursday 5th March 2026

Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to remind you that World Book Day will be celebrated on Thursday 5th March. To mark the occasion, we are inviting all children to come to school dressed as a character from a book. Each year group will hold its own costume parade and staff will select one winner per year group. Winners will receive a £5 book token to spend at the book fair.

In addition to the costume fun, children are invited to bring a book from home to share with a buddy during a visit to the Reading Café. This could link to their costume or be a personal favourite. Throughout the day, there will be a strong focus on reading with opportunities for quiet reading time and discussion about favourite books and characters.

Each class will also run a competition to find the most unusual place to be found reading. Children are invited to bring a photograph of themselves reading in an unusual place if they wish. They will have the chance to share their photograph with their class and explain where they were and what they were reading. We hope to create a display of the photographs in school.

At the end of the day, we will be hosting a book quiz around the school grounds for children to complete with their parents. Quiz sheets will be given out and further information about the starting point will be shared on the day.

We are also pleased to announce that a Scholastic Book Fair will be taking place from Monday to Thursday in Orchard Hall starting at 3:20 pm each day. Children will receive their £1 World Book Day token on Monday which can be used at the fair. Every purchase helps us to buy more books for our classrooms.

We look forward to celebrating the joy of reading with the children and hope the day fosters a lifelong love of reading for all our pupils at Loose.
