WHAT HAVE WE LEARNT?

English: Sightings have been made across Loose of the Lonely Beast and the children were very excited to see the pictures that had been captured! We have been looking at writing descriptions of what the Beast is like and why he may have visited Loose.

Phonics: We have been learning the /oo/ sound spelt /oo/, /u/ and /oul/. Examples of words with these spellings include 'book', 'put' and 'could'. Please also continue to work on the sounds on the sheets that we send home!

Maths: Identifying the number of tens and ones in a two digit number. We have also been learning to read and write numbers 20 to 50.

Science: We are continuing to investigate materials with a focus on their different properties.

Geography: We have been learning about what a continent is and labelling the different continents on a world map.

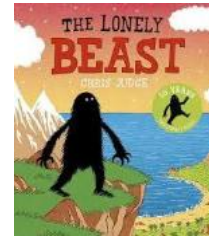
RE: We are continuing to identify ways in which Jesus is important to Christians through stories such as 'The Lost Sheep'.
