Geography: We have taken an exciting trip over the last week, complete with our own passports and tickets to explore different continents!

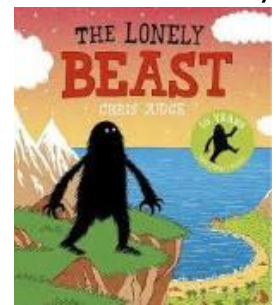
RE: We looked at what the 'Miracles of Jesus' teach us about Christian beliefs this week and read a story about Jesus healing people.
