Dear Year Three Parents and Carers,

This term has been amazing so far and, as we approach the final week of term, we need to do some serious celebrating! Each class has been fortunate enough to have Mrs Planck, our resident artist, working with them on weaving. It has been a real success and wonderful to see the children's individual interpretations. Forest School has also been a wonderful addition to the curriculum and just a reminder that there will be *no* forest school next week due to the church services.

Next week, the children will be publishing their 'stories with a moral'. Again, the children have loved putting their own spin on storylines. However, along with developing a sense of audience, the children have also worked on using prepositions of time, ambitious vocabulary, commas in a list and direct speech.

In maths we have been working on fractions. It would be great if you could incorporate fractions into day-to-day activities, for example, 'Please could you split these sweets into quarters?' 'What would be more, half of this cake or half of this cake?' The Easter break would also be a wonderful chance for children to practise telling the time using an analogue clock or watch, as we will be working on 'time' before the end of the year. Ideally, children should be able to tell the time using language such as '25 to 8' or '10 past 2' rather than just the digital displays.

If you are able to walk with your child's class to the church on Thursday 2nd, please do let your child's teacher know via the blue book.

Just a reminder that Coral Class have finished swimming now for this year; they have loved having the longer sessions. In Term 5 it will be Jade Class and in Term 6 it will be Amber Class.
