### WHAT HAVE WE LEARNT?

**English:** We are considering using adjectives and conjunctions to make our writing more exciting!

**Phonics:** We will continue with learning sounds of the week though as we continue to prepare children for Year 2 we will have a stronger focus on syllable words.

**Maths:** We have been studying numbers to 100, ensuring our knowledge of place value and comparing numbers is secure.

**Science:** We have been using our knowledge of plants to focus on trees. We know the difference between deciduous and evergreen and we have been identifying particular trees through looking at their leaves and bark.

**Geography:** Building on our knowledge of continents, we are learning about the 5 oceans of the world.

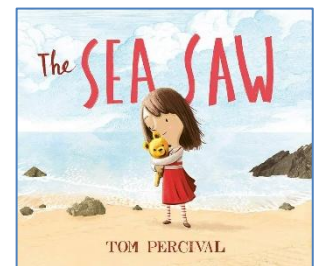
**RE:** We are considering places of worship this term. So far, we have learnt about the Synagogue and what items are important to Jewish people.
