Pupil Survey Results

Mr Hogwood explained that he had called this meeting to discuss the results of the recent Pupil Survey. He said that the majority of the results were very positive, but there were a couple of concerns that he wished to raise.

a) Challenging Work

Mr Hogwood stated that approximately 20% of students felt that they weren't challenged enough at school and asked for the reps thoughts. Many of the reps agreed that they didn't feel challenged enough in some areas of the curriculum and the subject that most felt lacking was maths.

Action: Mr Hogwood to invite Miss Whitlock to the next meeting to discuss and answer questions.

b) Behaviour of Students In and Out of the Classroom

Mr Hogwood stated that approximately 40% felt that behaviour was not good in or outside of the classroom. This led to much discussion regarding what bad behaviour they had experienced and many commented that they felt behaviour declined when supply teachers stood in. This then led onto what steps the school could take to improve behaviour.

The behaviour ladder was mentioned and the majority of reps felt that it didn't help to improve behaviour. So what could be implemented?

Action: Mr Hogwood asked each rep to discuss ways that the school could manage behaviour. He stated that he would send a form to each class with discussion points and would like it returned to him, completed, **by Friday 25th May.**
