

Behaviour expectations / policy addendum May 2020


Bubble rules (class charter) will be shared with pupils and will sit alongside our current Behaviour policy expectations and practices.

The school will apply strict sanctions, up to and including exclusion to any pupils who wilfully refuse to adhere to arrangements of social distancing and deliberately cough or spit at pupils or staff, putting them at risk.

Uniform is encouraged but if outgrown, children are allowed, during term 6, to wear their own clothing and sensible footwear.

Children / parents will ensure they:

- follow any altered routines for arrival or departure
- follow rules about what they can and cannot bring into school
- arrive and depart from school at the allocated, staggered start and finish times
- follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising
- follow instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school
- move around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing)
- understand expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- follow rules about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles and lunches
- follow amended expectations about breaks or play times, including where children may or may not play
- follow correct use of allocated toilets
- understand clear rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person



Loose Primary Bubble Rules

-  I will stay 2 metres away from others
-  I will regularly wash my hands throughout the day for 20 seconds
-  I will tell an adult if I feel unwell;
-  I will not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;
-  I will only use my own equipment;
-  I will not mix with children in a different bubble in school;
-  I will ask an adult when I need to use the toilet, so they can help keep me safe;
-  I will use the catch it-bin it-kill it rules coughing and sneezing into my elbow or a tissue;
-  I will follow the rules at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
-  I will follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I may be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
