Our school is delighted to provide the online reading resource 'Bug Club'. This has been very successful over the last few years and complements your child's reading with online books they can access. As your child is new to Bug Club this year, we hope you will find this information useful to get started. You can find Bug Club at [www.activelearnprimary.co.uk](http://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk) using your child's login and password which will be noted in their home learning journal and sent home next week. You can also access Bug Club on our own website ([www.loose-primary.kent.sch.uk](http://www.loose-primary.kent.sch.uk)) from the Pupil Zone tab.

We are all very excited about Bug Club and hope your child will enjoy accessing their e-books; they can also collect points and rewards to motivate them to read and enjoy more books. Teachers can view their progress as they read.

The more opportunities we provide for our pupils to read, the more confident and fluent they will become from a young age. Each time your child spots the 'bug' icon on a page it means they need to answer a question. This enables children to really develop their understanding of the text as well as their word reading skills. Your child's teacher will check their account and allocate new books accordingly. Children can also re-read books that are stored in their 'My Library' area.

You should be able to access Bug Club from any web browser on a desktop or laptop computer which supports Flash. If you have an iPad, you will need to have the Puffin app or similar. It may work on other devices but Pearson, who provide the service, cannot guarantee this.

There are so many different ways to enjoy reading and we hope that Bug Club adds a new, exciting dimension!
