To really bring their report to life, the children have included a wide range of features found in non – fiction texts such as, subheadings, captions and descriptive language. They have also continued to make good progress towards understanding and including a wide range of conjunctions and prepositions. The children have also started their assessments and the determination and resilience they have shown has been incredible!

In maths this week we have continued to build our understanding of addition and subtraction and are now applying this when problem solving. This has introduced the children to a new level of challenge as they are building their mathematical vocabulary. This new vocabulary will continue to develop throughout the year and as they master it, the children will grow in confidence.

In science, we have continued to develop our understanding of magnets by looking at how magnets are used in our everyday lives. The children were fascinated with how magnets are used to keep fridges cool, pick up cars and make trains levitate. We also have been improving our confidence when using scientific vocabulary by explaining how magnets can either attract or repel certain materials.

This week we have also taken the next step with our weaving and they look amazing! The children have worked very hard and thought carefully about their colour palette in order to create their chosen landscape. We would like to thank all the grown-ups who have volunteered their time to support us and the children. This is a new skill for many of our children and your kindness and positivity has been such a big help.
