#### Maths:

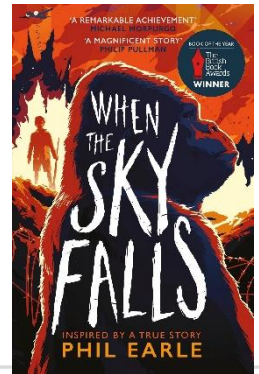
